

We have missed you all!

Hi everyone

We hope that you have all managed to keep well in these strange times. I never thought that we would be closed for so long.

We do not yet have a date to start up but we are working on it.

We are hoping to restart classes in the next few weeks (dates to be decided) but there are some changes and restrictions so please read this carefully.

As most of our venues are not big enough to accommodate our class numbers with the current restrictions we are moving to the Rendezvous Hotel in Skipton. We are going to run 3 classes there on Tuesdays only.

Times (hopefully) as follows-

Morning 10am to noon

Afternoon 1.30pm to 3.30 pm

Evening 7.30pm to 9.30 pm.

There is a bus stop near the hotel and a car park.

This means that we are not returning to Glusburn Institute, Broughton Road Centre or Central Hall in Keighley as none of them are big enough to accommodate our numbers. I am sorry for any disappointment.

Instead there will be an afternoon class for you on Tuesday afternoon at the Rendezvous Hotel, or Tuesday evening if you prefer. It is situated on Keighley Road on the outskirts of Skipton. There is a bus stop nearby and a car park.

We will be using the Malham Suite which is a large 300 square meter ballroom

***Monday afternoon at Glusburn and Wednesday afternoon at Keighley are relocating to the Rendezvous on Tuesday afternoon. 1.30pm to 3.30 pm***

***Tuesday morning Skipton class will be relocating there. 10am to noon***

***Tuesday evening will be there as normal. 7.30pm to 9.30 pm***

This will be a permanent venue because I am wanting to reduce the number of classes that I do as Peter is now retired. I hope you understand and will be able to attend.

Numbers at the moment are likely to be limited to 28 people per class (including Peter and myself) so you will need to pre book each week.

***You are not required to wear a mask while dancing.***

You will be spaced 3 meters apart in staggered lines, ie. 5 on front row, 4 on next row then 5 again so that you have 3 meters between your neighbour and 6 meters in front of you.

Please read the following carefully...

### **In Hotel**

1. Do not attend class if you or anyone in your household is ill.
2. Do not arrive too early or congregate in the hotel.
3. Before entering the hotel please sanitize your hands.
4. Masks must be worn at all times in the hotel corridors. They will not be worn while dancing.
5. Only 1 person or household in the lift at once.
6. There is a one way system in the hotel
7. After class please leave immediately, do not stand around to chat. Masks again must be worn.
8. Only 1 person at a time in the toilets.

## In Class

9. Your name and contact number will be kept for 21 days after attending.
10. Please bring correct money.
11. Bring your own water.
12. Doors and windows to be open at all times.
13. No fans are allowed as they move the air. Also no air conditioning.
14. No singing or raised voices.
15. For dancing a distance of 9 square meters per person (3 meters between each person to the front, back and each side). Take small steps to stay in your own space.
16. If not dancing please remember to stay 2 meters apart.
17. Chairs ??? To be decided as they are fabric covered.

Please note that all this is just work in progress at the moment and could be subject to change depending on any change in circumstances.

All this sounds really daunting but we will still able to enjoy our dancing and still have fun!

Please reply to this email to let me know if you feel ready to start again yet or not.

If you know someone who does not have an email please let them know.
